A Greyt Recipe for Easter or Passover:

Flowers and Chocolate are NOT for dogs! In fact, either or both can be toxic. Celebrate with your hound by making some treats.



Oatmeal Peanut Butter Dog Treats

Preheat oven to 325 degrees, line 2 cookie sheets with parchment paper.

Ingredients:

2 cups oatmeal (Quick cooking or Old Fashioned)

1 cup all purpose flour

1/2 cup peanut butter (plain or crunchy)

3/4 cup milk

1 egg

Mix oatmeal and flour in a large bowl, add peanut butter and mix together with a hand or stand mixer until peanut butter is incorporated, add milk and egg and mix until a dough is formed. Turn dough out onto a floured board or counter, add some flour if the dough is too sticky to handle and knead in, then pat dough down with your hands until it is about 1/2 inch thick.

Cut dough into rectangles or use a cookie cutter if bone shapes are desired.

Place treats on the parchment lined cookie sheets. Bake for about an hour or until hard (like a dog biscuit!) Remove from the oven and cool on a rack.

The treats will keep in an airtight container for a few days. I freeze the rest in a Ziploc bag and replenish the cookie jar as needed.
